Hard Standing pitch with electricity for 2 adults - £21 per night

CHECK IN/OUT

Check in between 13:00 and 18:00 at the reception.

Check out between 08:00 and 12:00.

Early Check in and Late check out may be available at a cost; please check with reception for availability beforehand.

RECEPTION

Staff are available between 08:00 hours and 22:00 hours every day, during the spring and summer season. Outside these hours, a member of staff will generally be available 3 hours before high water and 3 hours after high water.

If there is a '999' emergency, please use the emergency telephone, which is located near the reception to call the emergency services. Also call the emergency out of hours staff member on 07422963282 or 07951730669

FIRE ASSEMBLY POINT is located in the car park and if you need to vacate the site please assemble in an orderly manner.

SITE ACCESS

Access to the park is restricted by security barriers which is operated by using a code to open the barrier, this code can be obtained from reception during check in. Please do not pass on the barrier code to anyone else, e.g. friends, visitors.

The code will be changed regularly, to prevent unauthorised access.

Site of Special Scientific Interest

On the old railway bank, which protects the marina from the prevailing winds, we have a Site of Special Scientific Interest. It is home to a number of plants, including the Kidney Vetch that provides a life line for the Small Blue Butterfly.





FIRE SAFETY

Please park your caravan or motorhome to the right hand side of the pitch. When parking your vehicle, please ensure you have at least 3 metres clear space from the next caravan or motorhome, to restrict the spread of fires.

There is a fire box located which is located in the middle of the site, see plan on previous page. There is 2 x 10 litre water extinguishers, these should only be used by competent persons, who do not put themselves in danger.

On discovering a fire:

1. Raise the alarm
2. Ensure the affected unit is evacuated.
3. Call the Fire Service, by picking up the emergency telephone near reception.
4. Ensure all person are evacuated to the fire point.
5. If competent, attack the fire using the fire extinguishers provided.

CARBON MONOXIDE can kill, please ensure that fuel-burning appliance are serviced and not used inside your awning. Carbon Monoxide sensors can be used and fitted easily to any living accommodation, please keep you and your family safe.

ELECTRICITY is available on site from the 16 amp sockets, please ensure your cable connecting to the caravan or motorhome is fit for purpose.

Our sockets are there for the convenience of our customers, overloading a socket or faulty goods will trip the system. If this does happen please contact a member of staff, to reset the socket.

BOAT AREAS (pontoons and hard standing) are restricted and no person should walk around these areas, as they are classed as highly dangerous to a none boat owner. Anyone found on the site, will be politely asked to leave and access will be restricted to the marina complex.

GAS BOTTLES

Calor Gas and Camping gas bottles can be purchased, please see a member of staff for more information.

AMENITIES BLOCK

We have separate male and female showers/toilets, along with a family disabled facilities, within the marina complex. These can be accessed by leaving a £10.00 deposit per fob, which will give you access through the pedestrian gate, see plan.

AWNINGS

On the pitch you have permission for one car and caravan or a motorhome and awning. Caravan owners wishing to use an awning, must park their car on the car park. While driving on site you must keep your vehicle speed to below 5 mph and obey the one way system in place on the site. A car is permitted to be parked on your pitch as long as you have not pitched an awning.

LAUNDRY FACILITIES

We have coin operated washers, dryers and iron, with ironing board that is open 24 hours per day at the end of the amenity block. Also situated in the room is a vending machine for snacks and cold drinks.

BARBEQUES are permitted on site, however they must be purpose built and or stand clear of the ground, as to not damage the ground.

Open fires are not permitted on site.

PETS are welcome on the park, however they are to be kept on a short lead, not to cause a nuisance or left in your caravan/motorhome unsupervised. Please remember to clean up after you pet.

BALL GAMES, Frisbees and/or kite flying is not permitted on the park. However there is plenty of open spaces surrounding the park which may be used.

RECYCLING AND GENERAL WASTE

General waste bins, card/paper and glass bins are located in the marina complex near the amenity facility

ELSAN POINT is available adjacent to the building, see plan for location.
